REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Applicants must be a direct relative, natural, adopted, or a stepchild of a current ARCA Member. (Employees or relatives of employees of ARCA are not eligible for this program).
- 2) Applicants should have completed their college entrance test prior to November 1, 2010.
- 3) Applicants must complete the Bob Loga Memorial College Fund Application. Application may be obtained by going to arcaracing.com, click on the Competitors Website Icon, once in the Competitors Website, click on the icon titled Scholarships. Applications may also be obtained through the ARCA Office, 734-847-6726.
- 4) Applicants must have a high school counselor or principal complete the high school course outline form.
- 5) Applications must obtain two to three recommendations from unrelated individuals, who will comment on the applicant's motivation, ability, potential, and character. One such recommendation must be from an instructor who has taught the applicant, in an academic capacity, within two years of the date of application.
- 6) Applicant must write a brief essay, approximately one page in length, expressing educational and career aspirations. The essay must be type written.
- 7) Applicant must maintain at least a 2.25 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- 8) Applications must be received no later than November 15, 2010.
