All credentialing Thursday, Friday, Saturday (and Sunday, if needed) will be located at 1957 Dunn Avenue, Daytona Beach, FL.

Any individual without a 2019 ARCA license will pay a \$30 fee for test credential. 2019 ARCA license can be purchased at test Registration/Credentials. Driver licenses and documents not delivered to Joe Wells by Friday, January 5 may not be approved/processed in time for test.

Pre-Daytona test checklist:

- Driver approval documents emailed to Joe Wells Jwells@arcaracing.com.
- Drivers must be approved to test at Daytona (Contact Joe Wells).
- Driver must have an approved physical, HIPAA, drug screen and drug screen authorization on file with ARCA (physical, HIPAA, drug screen and drug screen authorization must be dated December 1, 2018 or more recent).
- Driver must have applied and paid for a **2019** ARCA Driver license.
- Car Owner must have a **2019** ARCA Car Owner license.
- Must have a paid entry for the **2019** Daytona race event.
- Must have a paid test fee for the Daytona test.
- It is the responsibility of the registered team owner to ensure all driver documents and fees are transacted prior to going on track.
- All fees and documents must be on file with Joe Wells at the ARCA office by Friday January 5.
- **Failure to comply will subject driver/team to dismissal from Test.**

- **No overnight parking, however, motor coaches allowed in infield during test days.**
- Garage/pit area proper attire rules for active participants apply at test: No shorts, no short skirts, no open-toe shoes, no bare midriff and no sleeveless shirts.
- Car at minimum must have legible numbers on both doors.
- Car must have the windshield ARCA bar, ARCA Racing Series presented by Menards logo, ARCA bar, General Tire logo on the back of the spoiler, over the front tires and on front fender/nose, and Menards logo on front of the rear spoiler.
- General Tire will be on site to service team needs.
- Sunoco Unleaded 260 GTX will be available for purchase at the track.
- For restrictor plate needs, contact Cometic, 440-354-0777.
- For ACCEL/Holley needs, contact Graham Fordyce 775-250-5740.
- Racing Electronics, Holley, Ilmor and JRI Shocks representatives will be on hand to service team needs.

OPTIONAL INSPECTION TIMES

- Fuel cell inspection will be available daily from 7:00 am – 10:00 am.
- Template/heights will be available for inspection daily from 9:00 am – 12:00 n.
- Engine inspection will be available daily from 1:00 pm – 3:00 pm.
- Under car inspection will be available daily from 2:00 pm – 5:00 pm.

ON TRACK PROCEDURES:

- There will be a driver and spotter meeting in the Driver Meeting room near the Fan Zone at 8:00 am each morning. All drivers and spotters are required to attend at least one meeting **PRIOR TO** on track activity.
- All teams must have all documents in order and on file with ARCA prior to going on track. It is the responsibility of the team to verify completion of all paperwork with ARCA no later than Friday January 5.
- All cars to be ARCA legal (**all heights, springs, restrictor plate, etc.**) for on-track activity.
- Teams using any **non-compliant parts** at any time, **crew chief will be held responsible and the car owner** will be fined at minimum \$1000 and have equipment confiscated and time disallowed.
- Obey the direction of ARCA official on pit road.
- Obey traffic flow in the garage and on pit road.
- Stay on apron through turn 2 (minimum) when entering race track.
- Limit number of laps to ten per session (non-drafting).
- **MUST HAVE SPOTTER ON TOP OF CONTROL TOWER, FUNCTIONING RACE SAFE SYSTEM AND TWO-WAY RADIO COMMUNICATION WHENEVER RACE CAR IS ON TRACK.**
- **Route to spotter stand – (Link).**
- Maintain distance from other cars when on single car runs.
- Return all transponders and remove all tape and clean garage area before leaving track.
