NEW REGISTRATION PROCEDURES, DAYTONA INT'L SPEEDWAY ARCA OPEN TEST 12-5-17

All race team members and guests participating in the ARCA Open Test at Daytona Int'l Speedway January 12-13 (weather date 14) will be required to follow registration procedures and obtain a garage credential, similar to the Daytona race event. No vehicle parking pass is required, however all individuals entering the infield/garage area are required to have one of the following and be prepared to present to Speedway Security and/or ARCA Official as requested:

1. A single event credential issued to them at ARCA Registration
2. Daytona Int'l Speedway-issued credential
3. 2018 ARCA Photo ID Credential

The Registration location at Dunn Avenue ([Daytona Credential Office Location](#)) will be open as follows:

Thursday, January 11, 2-7pm

Friday, January 12, 6am-4pm

Saturday, January 13, 7am-4pm

Anyone who has purchased, or purchases on site, a 2018 ARCA license ([2018 - ARS License Application](#)) will sign Release & Waiver document, be issued a single event garage credential and be admitted at no charge. Anyone who has not purchased a 2018 ARCA license will sign Release & Waiver document, be issued a single event garage credential and be charged \$30.

Anyone who has in their possession prior to the test a 2018 ARCA Photo ID Credential may proceed to the Garage Area and execute the Release & Waiver. 2018 ARCA Photo ID Credentials may be purchased at the Test, but will not be processed on site. **2017 ARCA Photo ID Credentials are not valid.**

Driver Approval documents (including Medical Minor Consent Form), Entry Fee documents and Test Entry Fee documents will be processed at the Dunn Avenue Registration location on Thursday from 2-7pm and on Friday from 6-9am only. Transponders will only be issued to drivers who have properly completed all registration documents, which are available in advance from Joe Wells (jwells@arcaracing.com).

Anyone under the age of 18 years of age will be admitted only if (1) the Daytona Int'l Speedway "Parental Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement" and "Acknowledgment and Assumption of Risk" ([Florida Competitor Minor Release](#)) forms and (2) the ARCA "Parental Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement" and "Minor's Assumption of Risk and Release and Waiver of Liability" ([2018 ARCA Minor Consent Form](#)) both are executed by a parent/legal guardian. If forms are not executed on site, legal guardian signature must be notarized. There will be no exceptions.
