Re: ARCA Pocono test May 30<sup>th</sup>, with the 31<sup>st</sup> scheduled as a weather contingency date, in preparation for the General Tire #Anywhere is Possible 200 race June 1, 2018.

Credentials obtained for the ARCA open test at Pocono Wednesday, May 30 will be valid through the end of the ARCA Racing Series presented by Menards event Friday, June 1 or rescheduled date/time if postponed.

All credentialing race week will be located on Long Pond Road near the tunnel turn.

Rig staging – From Interstate 80, take Highway 115 to Long Pond Road and enter track property at Gate 5. Stage behind main grandstand.

All individuals entering the garage area at the test must be credentialed by ARCA.

## Pre-Pocono test checklist:

- Driver approval documents emailed to Joe Wells [Jwells@arcaracing.com](mailto:Jwells@arcaracing.com).
- Drivers must be approved to test at Pocono (Contact Joe Wells).
- Driver must have an approved physical, HIPAA, drug screen and drug screen authorization on file with ARCA (physical, HIPAA, drug screen and drug screen authorization must be dated December 1, 2017 or more recent).
- Driver must have applied and paid for a **2018** ARCA Driver license.
- Car Owner must have a **2018** ARCA Car Owner license.
- Must have a paid entry for the **2018** Pocono race event.
- Must have a paid test fee for the Pocono test.
- It is the responsibility of the registered team owner to ensure all of their driver's paperwork and fees are transacted prior to going on track.
- Driver Approval documents (including Medical Minor Consent Form), Race Entry Fee documents and payment, and Test Entry Fee documents and payment should be submitted to the ARCA office by the due date (May 21). Documents and payments not submitted in advance will only be processed from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. Wednesday at the Long Pond Road Credential location and will be subject to a late filing fee. Transponders will only be issued to drivers who have properly completed all registration documents and payments.

Non-compliance in any manner will result in fine.
- **No overnight parking, however, motor coaches allowed in infield during test day Wednesday, May 30.**
- Garage/pit area proper attire rules for active participants apply at test: No shorts, no short skirts, no open-toe shoes, no bare midriff and no sleeveless shirts. Anyone to be credentialed is to be listed on team list provided to ARCA in advance.
- Car at minimum must have legible numbers on both doors.
- Car must have the windshield ARCA bar, ARCA Racing Series presented by Menards logo, ARCA bar, General Tire logo on the back of the spoiler, over the front tires and on front fender/nose, and Menards logo on front of the rear spoiler.
- General Tire will be on site to service team needs.
- Sunoco Unleaded 260 GTX will be available for purchase at the track.
- For ACCEL/Holley needs, contact Graham Fordyce 775-250-5740.
- Racing Electronics, Holley and Ilmor representatives will be on hand to service team needs.

## ON TRACK PROCEDURES:

- There will be a driver and spotter meeting in the Pocono Penthouse Club at 8:00 am Wednesday, May 30 (8:00 am Thursday, May 31 if needed). All drivers and spotters are required to attend at least one meeting **PRIOR TO** on track activity.
- All teams must have all paperwork in order and on file with ARCA prior to going on track. It is the responsibility of the team to verify completion of all paperwork with ARCA no later than 8:00 am Wednesday, May 30.
- All cars to be ARCA legal for on-track activity.
- Teams using any **non-compliant parts** at any time, **crew chief will be held responsible and the car owner** will be fined at minimum \$1000 and have equipment confiscated and time disallowed.
- Obey the direction of ARCA official on pit road.
- Obey traffic flow in the garage and on pit road.
- Stay on apron through turn 1 (minimum) when entering race track.
- Limit number of laps to ten per session.
- **MUST HAVE SPOTTER ON TOP OF CONTROL TOWER, FUNCTIONING RACE SAFE SYSTEM AND TWO-WAY RADIO COMMUNICATION WHENEVER RACE CAR IS ON TRACK.**
- **Route to spotter stand – Tunnel under track at frontstretch S/F line to elevator.**
- Maintain distance from other cars when on single car runs.
- Return all transponders and remove all tape and clean garage area before leaving track.
