The applicant must have at least 2 years of experience as a licensed Youth Steward and have the current Youth Steward license, Kart Course Designer license, and Kart Tech Inspector license by completing all four (4) of the necessary Junior Driver Program (JDP) training sessions.

A Solo Safety Steward Instructor (SSI) is eligible to be JDP Instructor without this additional license, but is welcome to apply. To be an instructor for JDP training, the SSI must also be currently licensed as (1) a Youth Steward, (2) a Kart Safety Inspector, and (3) either a licensed Kart Course Designer or has taken SSS training after January 1, 2018. (The "Overview: Kart Safety Awareness" and "Kart Course Design Training" have been incorporated into current SSS training.)

A letter of recommendation from a Divisional Solo Development Coordinator (SDC), Divisional Solo Safety Steward (DSSS), Solo Safety Committee member, Solo Safety Steward Instructor (SSI) who has worked with the applicant, or the applicant's Regional Executive (RE) must accompany this application.

This is a 3-year license.
