The Mazda competitor must finish ahead of four other starters in class to receive a 100% payout; awards are reduced by 15% for finishing ahead of three competitors; 25% for finishing ahead of two competitors; and 50% if ahead of one other competitor. No award available for last in class. To claim points championship prizes, competitor must compete in a minimum of three events. Three events must have at least five starters in class. If any of these three events had contingency reduced due to not meeting the requirement, the points championship award will be reduced by the same percentage.
