The Mazda competitor must finish ahead of four other starters in class to receive a 100% payout; awards are reduced by 15% for finishing ahead of three competitors; 25% for finishing ahead of two competitors; and 50% if ahead of one other competitor. No award available for last in class. SCCA Solo Triad award winners must win at least two Championship Tour events and a Solo National Championship in the same class.
