**Join us in Georgetown, Texas at Republic Square  
for the SCCA Geronimo Memorial Road Rally.**

This event will be on the Saturday of the weekend before Father's Day, June 16, 2018. This is not a speed, time, distance event but there will be many wordplay puzzles to solve based on signs found along the routes. There will also be some "complete the quote", math, count, and word crop puzzles. Compute your answers and then mark your score sheet to indicate which ones you found.

On 16 June 1829 the Mescalero-Chiricahua leader and medicine man, Geronimo was born. He was active in the New Mexico-Arizona Indian wars of the 1850s through the 1886. After his third surrender in 1886, he was exiled to Florida. He was later sent to Ft Sill in Oklahoma but never returned to Arizona. He visited the 1904 World's Fair and was in President Theodore Roosevelt's inauguration parade in 1905. My favorite story is how he would sell the buttons off his clothes as souvenirs at railroad stops and then sew on new buttons before the next stop. He died at Ft Sill, OK in 1909 from pneumonia after a horse riding accident.

Starting Location: Republic Square in Georgetown at the intersection of I-35 north frontage road (exit 262 north or south), Texas 158, and Williams Drive. There is a Starbucks there and a McDonalds across Williams Drive.

Finish Meeting Point: is Louis Mueller in Taylor, Texas--founded in 1949 – Brisket, ribs, sausage, pork loin, turkey and sides. Stay for desert of homemade Peach Cobbler, Blue Bell Ice Cream, and Banana.

Vehicles: Anything with 4 wheels that is street legal. Bring something that you will have fun driving on city streets.

Cars built low to the ground or with stiff suspensions might have trouble at railroad crossings or dirt roads.

Vehicles must be in good condition and have a current state inspection sticker.

Participants: Each car must have at least two people old enough to read. The driver must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance.

Rally Fee: \$20.00 for SCCA Members or for non-SCCA members.

Awards for placing first or second in your first event, in novice class, and other categories.

Minor Children (<18) are welcome but a Minor Waiver form signed by both parents in the presence of either the rally registrar or a Notary Public will be required.
