



## ***IMPORTANT INFORMATION IF TOWING INTO CALIFORNIA FOR THE 2018 RUNOFFS***

There are specific transportation rules in California regarding emissions and oversized tow vehicle/trailer combinations. We have gathered information and links to California government sites with information and forms. While the information provided is intended to assist drivers/owners/teams with compliance efforts, it is the sole responsibility of truck/trailer owners to ensure compliance with the regulations in which they are subject to. Please review the information carefully so that you fully understand the rules and requirements. ### **FOR DIESEL TRUCK/TRAILERS:**

All owners of diesel trucks and buses that operate in California, are required to take steps to reduce air pollution. The following link is a document that summarizes the requirements and key dates for upgrading existing equipment.

### **MOTORSPORTS PERMIT FOR OVERSIZED TOW VEHICLE (Truck, Toter, RV)/TRAILER COMBINATIONS (Overall length greater than 65 feet)**

Single Trip Transportation Permits (TR-0015) are required for qualified vehicles attending motorsports events. The cost of the permit is \$16 and the permit application form must be submitted by fax to (916) 322-4966. **The TR-0015 is only valid for seven days.** Anyone staying in California longer than that will need to re-apply.
